TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS & REFUND Policy

1. The Tournament will be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations laid down by the Tennis Victoria for the carrying out of tournaments, save as altered by this program and conditions.
2. The Committee shall have the entire management of the Tournament.
3. Entry Fees must accompany Entry Forms. No phone entries accepted. Entries without Fees will not be accepted. In the event of insufficient entries, the Committee reserves the right to cancel any events.
4. Entries are restricted in all events and will be taken on a first in basis. Players will be regraded if event limits are reached.
5. The Committee reserves the right to re-grade any players as it thinks fit at any time of entry and to re-grade any player at any time.
6. A Timetable will be used for the entire Tournament. Players not at courts at required times will be scratched. Play will commence at **8.30 a.m. on all days. Players are required to report to the Tournament Room 15 minutes prior to their scheduled match**
7. Players can enter a maximum of four (4) events. Player can enter only one (1) mixed doubles event. Players are only allowed to enter 2 consecutive grades. A junior may only play in 2 singles events. A junior may only play 1 junior doubles and 1 graded doubles event.
8. Previous winners of the A Grade singles are not allowed to play in lower grade singles.
9. Junior events will be played on Hard Courts which are located 1 km from the grass courts.
10. Regulation tennis attire must be worn.
11. Should a dispute arise upon any point, the matter shall be submitted to the Referee whose decision shall be final.
12. Juniors must be under age as at April 30 2017. Veterans must be over 40 as at April 30 2017. **Entries for Combined 10 and Under Doubles are taken on an INDIVIDUAL BASIS. Players will be paired up with different partners during the Round Robin.**
13. Men's and Women's Legend 100+ Doubles: The players combined ages must be equal to or greater than 100 years. Seniors may play in both Veteran's and Legends events.
14. Matches will be A Grade - 8 game set, tie breaker at 7 all; Round Robin 8 game set, tie break at 7 all; B & C & D Grade - 8 game set, tie breaker at 7 all; Junior - 6 game set; tie breaker at 5 all. Sudden Death deuce is played in all events.
15. Refunds will not be issued to players who withdraw after Friday 31 March 2017 or if an event is cancelled due to inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances.
16. The Dunlop "Grand Prix" ball will be used exclusively during this event
17. **All Senior Singles will be a knockout competition. Junior Singles is initial Round Robin then knockout competition. All Doubles and Mixed will be an initial Round Robin, then knockout competition.**

 - Saturday: Singles and Doubles**
 - Sunday: Singles and Doubles Finals. Mixed to start**
 - Monday: Mixed and Doubles Finals**
